### **ELIGIBILITY FOR ADMISSION:**

Candidates with any of the following criteria are eligible for admission:

- Bachelor's degree (Honors) or its equivalent in any field. Candidates must have obtained a minimum of 2<sup>nd</sup> Class/Division or CGPA-2.5.
- BA/BSS (Pass). Candidates of Pass Course must have 05 (Five) years of job experience in the development field.
- Armed forces officers/personnel with any of the above-mentioned degree. Candidates with BA/BSS (pass) degree must have 05 (Five) years' service in the Armed Forces.

### **NOTES ON ELIGIBILITY:**

- For qualifications/degrees other than those mentioned, equivalence will be determined by Equivalence Committee of BUP.
- Eligible applicants will have to appear a Written Admission Test followed by a Viva-Voce.
- Date, time, and list of eligible candidates for Admission Test will be published in website and campus notice board and will be notified also through email.
