- MBBS, BDS or MD or equivalent Professional degree in Medical Sciences (Homeopathy, Unani & Ayurvedic, Physiotherapy, BSc in Nursing etc.) or Four-year Undergraduate Degree from a UGC recognized University in life Sciences, Social Sciences, Anthropology, Psychology.
- Professional Public Health Experience will be preferred.
- Proficiency in oral and written English and basic Mathematics.
- Basic Computer Skills including Microsoft Office and Data Analysis Software Preferred.
