- Applicants who have taken the A-Level Examination must pass at least two (02) subjects with a minimum of grade C in each of these subjects.
- MBBS, BDS or MD or equivalent Professional degree in Medical Sciences (Homeopathy, Unani & Ayurvedic, Physiotherapy, BSc in Nursing etc.) or Four-year Undergraduate Degree from a UGC recognized University in life Sciences, Social Sciences, Anthropology, Psychology, Computer Sciences & Information Technology.
- At least Second Class in all exams or a minimum CGPA of 2.50 on a 4-point scale.
- Professional Public Health Experience will be preferred.
- Proficiency in oral and written English and basic Mathematics.
- Basic Computer Skills including Microsoft Office and Data Analysis Software Preferred.
- An entrance exam designed to measure basic writing, numeric and logical skills may be required of all students.
